

CLUE: ON STAGE CHARACTERS

All roles available to actors of any gender.

WADSWORTH (m) - A traditional British butler in every sense: uptight, formal and “by the book.” He is the driving force in the play.

YVETTE (f) - A loyal and sexy, French Maid, with her own secret aspirations

MISS SCARLET (f) - A dry, sardonic D.C. madam, more interested in secrets than sex

MRS. PEACOCK (f) - The wealthy wife of a Senator. A bit batty, neurotic, and quick to hysteria.

MRS. WHITE (f) - A pale, morbid, and tragic woman. Mrs. White may or may not be the murderer of her five ex-husbands.

COLONEL MUSTARD (m) - A puffy, pompous, dense, blow-hard of a military man

PROFESSOR PLUM (m) - An arrogant academic, easily impressed by himself

MR. GREEN (m) - A timid, yet officious, rule follower. He’s awfully anxious, and clumsy.

3-4 actors will cover the following roles as well as the voice of the Newscaster, voice of McCarthy, body doubles for theatrical trickery, and more

THE COOK (f) - a gruff woman with a threatening presence, is killed

SINGING TELEGRAM GIRL (f) - a tap dancer with a heart of gold, is killed

MR. BODDY (m) - a slick, Frank Sinatra, film noir-esque fella, is killed

THE MOTORIST (any) - a professional driver, is killed

CHIEF OF POLICE (m) - a cop who helps save the day

BACKUP COP (any) - backup for the Chief in the final scene

UNEXPECTED COP (m) - a regular Joe, is killed
